







SEAN'S STORY


A short audio drama on the consequences of knife crime

It portrays the impact of choices on his future.






SIMINE'S STORY

It guides young people in making informed digital choices.






Katie's devotion to her boyfriend pulls her into the world of drug dealing.

The narratives offer insight and empathy. They underscore the urgent need to address knife crime.






ELLES FOODBYE ELLES STORY

It emphasises the toll of gang involvement on youth.










Gemma's relationship with Ethan turns controlling, and she faces difficult decisions.

This film highlights the allure and dangers of gang culture. It fosters discussion about the risks of being trapped.








BUNDIRUES

This film is based on real-life events. It encourages healthy discussions on respecting personal space.






LINITE II WE STANIS

This story explores friendship amid societal divides. It emphasises the impact of social unrest on relationships.








SISTERHOUT

This resource highlights the risks of gang involvement. It emphasises the cost of misplaced loyalty and self-preservation.






SHARP ENTS

This story portrays resilience in the face of violence. It explores the mental toll of surviving a traumatic experience.







A friend watches helplessly as her best friend endures an abusive relationship.

It highlights the importance of support and recognising warning signs.












A young man encounters peer pressure when friends introduce nitrous oxide.

It encourages critical thinking in challenging situations.










Callum, targeted by a gang, considers revenge with a friend's encouragement.

This story portrays loyalty and the power of resilience. It warns against the cycle of violence.










THE RESIDENT OF THE STATE OF TH

It prompts reflection on the weight of impulsive decisions.








HOLIJING THE BHG

It underscores the importance of thinking critically in risky situations.










In a world where reputation is everything, one viral moment threatens to destroy a young man's entire future.


Vivid Lines follows Joshua, a quiet teenager growing up in a volatile estate where street politics, music, and masculinity clash daily. Living in the shadow of his older brother Kylo, a well-respected local figure, Joshua keeps his head down until a video of him dancing goes viral. Overnight, he becomes the punchline in a drill diss track, humiliated and hounded by the streets.


Caught between pressure from his girlfriend Sarah, the weight of local reputation, and the trauma of online exposure, Joshua begins spiralling, haunted by anxiety, shame, and the growing temptation to restore his name with violence. The situation escalates, pushing him to make a life-altering decision: to pick up a knife and seek revenge.

As he teeters on the edge, James, a reformed street figure turned anti-violence activist, becomes the voice of reason. In a powerful final encounter, James challenges Joshua to see that real strength lies not in retaliation but in resisting the pull of the roads.

Vivid Lines is a raw, unfiltered portrait of urban youth under pressure, exploring the fragile line between pride and destruction, and the moments that can either make or break a life.











STOLEN YOUTH

Jayden, a 15-year-old boy growing up in an urban estate, thinks he's ahead of the game when he starts dating x, a confident 21-year-old woman with her own car, her own flat, and seemingly all the answers. To his friends, he's a legend, living fast and levelling up beyond their reach.

But beneath the surface, Chloe's attention isn't as flattering as it seems. As she showers Jayden with gifts and affection, she slowly draws him into a web of manipulation, secrecy, and control. What starts as flirty texts and late-night chats soon spirals into something darker: requests for private photos, emotional dependence, and silence around their "relationship."

Jayden believes he's in control until Chloe disappears and shatters his reality.





FULLS AREAL DIRECTION FOR THE STATE OF THE S

Mason, 14, feels trapped in a cycle of anger that spills over at home. What begins as shouting and smashed objects soon turns into violence towards his mum, the one person who has always stood by him.

Through raw reflection, Mason admits that he was repeating patterns he saw in his dad and realises the damage he has caused. A night in a young offenders unit becomes a turning point, leading him to seek support and start breaking the cycle.










Kian, caught up with the wrong crowd, drifts into drinking, shoplifting, and gang-fuelled antics. One heated moment leads to him pushing another boy, leaving the victim seriously injured in hospital and Kian staring down the criminal justice system. With prison on the table, he's instead given a referral order through Derby Youth Justice.

Supported by his mum but forced to confront the fallout of his antisocial behaviour, Kian must face the consequences of "just one push" and decide whether he'll break the cycle or get pulled deeper into it.
